

Colorful Waves Blanket

Worsted weight yarn – I used a total of 10 oz. /600 yds.

Note: (would be a little less if you did not do the border)

You need use 2 colors to show off the waves

J hook

Blanket size: 32” x 32”

Note: to increase the blanket size chain to desired length using multiples of 8 plus 2

Chain 82

Row 1: With color A sc in 2nd chain from hook, * sc in next chain hdc in next chain in next ch, dc in each of the next 3 ch, hdc in next ch, 1 sc in each of 2 ch, rep * across, turn.

Row 2: With color A, ch 1,(counts as 1st sc), skip 1st st, sc in each st across. Drop Color A, draw B through last loop, turn

Row 3: With color B, ch 3,(counts as 1st dc), skip 1st st, *dc in next st, hdc in next st, sc in each of next 3 sts, hdc in next st, dc in each of next 2 dc, rep from * across, ending with last dc in top of turning chain, turn

Row 4: With color B, ch 1,(counts as 1st sc), skip 1st st, sc in each st across. Drop Color A, draw A through last loop, turn

Row 5: With color A, ch 1 (counts as 1st sc), skip 1st st, sc in next st, * hdc in next st, dc in each of the next 3 sts, hdc in next st,**, sc in each of the next 3 sts, rep from * across, ending last rep at **, sc in next st, 1 sc in top of turning ch, turn

Rep rows: 2-5 for pattern.

Optional:

2 rows of SC around the entire edge of the blanket
