

Lacy Spring Crochet Blanket

Marti Manson

J hook

Worsted weight yarn 588 yards - I used Red Heart Super Saver

Dimensions of my finished blanket 32 X 30 inches but could make a square instead.

NOTE:

I am a "tight" crocheter so my gauge turned out to be – 4 V-stitches in 4 inches.

I have also discovered that I need to make my beginning chain at least 3 – 4 inches shorter than the finished length I want. My chain for this blanket would then be 28 inches long to end with a 32-inch blanket.



Directions:

Ch (Chain) 140 St (stitches) **OR** until your chain is approx. 28" long. Sc in the second chain from the hook, sc in each ch across. Ch 3, turn.

Row 1: *Skip next 2 sc, 1dc (double crochet), ch1, 1 dc in the next stitch, repeat from * across the row, end with dc in top of chain 3. ch 3, turn.

Row 2: *1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc in the ch 1 space of the previous row, repeat from * across the row ending with 1 dc in the top of the ch 3. Ch 3, turn.

Repeat Row 2 until the blanket is the desired length.

Last Row: Sc in each stitch across the row, end.
