

Colorful Knitted Stocking Cap

(created in the round and requiring knit and crochet)
Jeannie Duris

Uses 7 colors of yarn – worsted weight

Size 9 16” circular Needle

Size 9 DP (double pointed) Note that 9’s will give you a hat large enough for a medium sized adult. 7 a smaller adult or an older child. Using thinner yarn (with smaller needles) will result in smaller hats.

Color A Using circular needles
Cast on 80 stitches and join into a round being careful not to twist
K 6 rounds

Color B 5 rounds ribbing - k2, P2, around

Color C Knit 4 rounds
Purl 1 round
Knit 1 round

Color D Knit 4 rounds of seed stitch
(pattern below)

Color E Knit 2 rounds
Purl 1 round
Knit 2 rounds

Color F Knit 3 rounds
K1, P1 around round
K1, P1 around round

Color G P1, K1 around round
Knit 3 rounds
Purl 1 round

Color A K 1 round decreasing 8 stitches evenly
around – (K8, K2together) 72 sts
K 1 round
K 1 round decreasing 8 stitches evenly around
(K7, K2 together around) 64 sts
K1 round
P1, Slip 1 as it to purl, (P1, slip 1 is if to purl
around) the loops will be used to create
scallops/shells later

Color B K 2 rounds
Switch to DP needles, K 1 round decreasing
8 around (K6, K2 tog) 56 sts
P1 round
K round



- Color C
 K 1 round
 K 1 round decreasing 8 around (K5, K2 tog) 48 sts
 P 1 round
 K 1 round
 P 1 round
 K 1 round decreasing 8 sts around (K4 K2 tog) 40 sts
- Color D
 K1 round
 Make 4 rounds seed stitch using pattern given earlier
 K 1 round decreasing 8 st evenly around (K3, K2 tog) 32 sts left
- Color E
 K 2 rounds
 P 1, Slip 1 purlwise, (P1, slip 1 purlwise) around
 K 1 round
 K 1 round decreasing 8 around (K2, k2tog) 24 sts
 K 1 round
- Color F
 K 3 rounds
 P1, K1 around
 P1, K1 around
- Color G
 K1, P1 around
 K 4 rounds
 K1, P1 around
- Color A
 P1, K1 around
 K 3 rounds
 P 1 round
 K 1 round
- Color B
 K1, P1 around
 K 3 rounds
 P 1 round
 K 1 round
- Color C
 K 1 round
 P 1 round
 K 2 rounds
 P 1 round
 K 1 round
- Color D
 P 1 round
 K 4 rounds
 P1, K1 around
- Color E
 K1, P1 around
 K 1 round decreasing 8 stitches evenly around (K1, K2 tog) 16 sts
 K 3 rounds
 P 1 round



Color F K 5 rounds

P1 rounds
K 2 rounds

Color G P1, K1 around
K 5 rows

Cut 10" tail and draw through stitches on needles purlwise, pull tight and fasten off.

Scallops/shells row sections:

On section 8 (color A) through loops on outside sc, hdc. dc, tc, dc, hdc, sc around adjusting number of stitches as needed

On section 12 (color E) crochet scallops/shells through loops

On Section 16 (Color B), using garter stitch loops, crochet small shells

Weave in all ends

Make pompom using all colors and attach
