

Warm Ridges Blanket

Pam Greswolde

Approx. 800 yards of chunky weight yarn

Finished size: 30"x 48"

K hook

Gauge: 8 DC, SC, FPDC, SC = 4 ½ inches

Stitches: SC, DC, FPDC, BPDC

Chain 98

Row 1: DC in 4th ch from the hook, DC in next 3 st *skip next st, DC in next st, skip next st, DC in next 4 st. Repeat to the end, chain 3 and turn.

Row 2: DC in 1st 4 DC, * skip next st, FPDC in next st, skip next st, DC in next 4 st, * skip next st, FPDC in next st, skip next st, DC in next 4 st. Repeat to the end, chain 3 and turn.

Row 3: DC in 1st 4 DC, * skip next st, BPDC in next st, skip next st, DC in next 4 st, * skip next st, BPDC in next st, skip next st, DC in next 4 st. Repeat to the end, chain 3 and turn.

Repeat rows 2 and 3 until desired length is reached.

Notes:

Although I used chunky yarn for this blanket, it can be made the same way with worsted weight yarn and works well with 2 strands of mixed weight yarn. Leftovers make a very interesting combination with the ridges for something different.
